Administrative Appeal Decision

Appellant requests an administrative appeal of the state hearing decision issued on January 4, 2007. The state hearing decision determined that Appellant had stated no grounds for an appeal as there was no negative action or inaction taken with regard to his case.

Appellant requested a state hearing on December 11, 2006. Appellant failed to state any grounds for the appeal in his hearing request. At the hearing, Appellant described a conspiracy against him and complained in general terms about his treatment by the County Agency and ODJFS. Appellant failed to identify any specific issue for appeal. The hearing officer reviewed the Agency's most recent eligibility determination and determined that Appellant's benefits were correct. Appellant's administrative appeal request does not address the issue of his Medicaid benefits, but addresses the murder conspiracy issues that he discussed at the state hearing.

Having reviewed the state hearing decision, we agree with the hearing officer that Appellant's current level of benefits is correct and Appellant's other issues are not appealable through the state hearing process.

DECISION

Accordingly, we ORDER that the hearing decision is AFFIRMED.
